We are very pleased to announce that we will be working with Masala Caterers again this year who will provide a food stall where members will be able to purchase a variety of food options. They will be accepting cash so please bring change!

For your enjoyment this year we have also hired a professional singer and band to get everyone into the spirit of Navratri.

SKA members are permitted to bring non-member friends.

**Non-members** who are over the age of 16 will be charged an entrance fee of £3.00 per person.

The Executive Committee is committed to ensure these events are the best they can be for the entire community, which does come at additional costs. We are not charging SKA members to attend this event but we would appreciate a voluntary donation at the door so we can continue to host exciting events in the future with great entertainment, food and venues.

**In order to ensure that everyone has a great time, the venue has asked us to notify you all of the following requirements:**

To remain COVID compliant and ensure everyone's safety, everyone aged over 16 will be required to do a lateral flow test on the day of the event. To gain entry into the event, you will have to show us a picture of yourself holding a **NEGATIVE** lateral flow test, including your face, OR show us NHS confirmation after reporting it online. You can report your test here: <https://www.gov.uk/report-covid19-result>

In order to comply with Health and Safety Regulations and Fire Safety Regulations, no naked flames are permitted at the venue. This means no divas, candles, matches, agarbatti, kapoor, etc.

During the celebrations we will be using electric tea lights instead. Any members wishing to bring an Aarti thali must also use electric tea lights. If you do not have one, we will have a limited supply of spares available for you to use.

This year the Aarti will be held before the Dandiya Raas. Please be aware no prashad is to be handed out or consumed inside the main hall directly after the Aarti. We will provide a designated area outside the main hall to hand out prashad on exiting the venue. We ask that our members form an orderly queue.

Strictly no food or drink is allowed to be consumed inside main hall. There will be designated areas for food and drink around the venue. Those bringing in prashad (i.e. Indian mithais, fruits and nuts), please ensure you have them in small plastic bags for hygiene reasons. Chocolates in their own wrappers are fine.

Children must be supervised at all times. We ask that all of our members please be mindful of the above and observe the venue's requirements throughout. This is to ensure that everyone can safely enjoy the celebrations, and that the venue will welcome us back for future Navratri celebrations.



Please pass this message on to all friends and family who will be attending. The venue will have their own onsite security and anyone found not to be following the requirements may be asked to leave.

As always, we appreciate your support and look forward to seeing you all as we enjoy this special religious festival in our Hindu Calendar. We look forward to seeing you then.

## Naan Kathai Recipe

### Method - STEP 1

Split the cardamom pods and remove the seeds. Pound the seeds to a powder in a pestle and mortar with 1 tsp of the sugar.

**STEP 2** - Beat the butter until soft, then gradually add the remaining icing sugar and the ground cardamom. Continue beating until light and creamy, about 10 mins.

**STEP 3** - Sieve the flour and gram flour into a bowl and whisk in the semolina and a pinch of salt. Stir into the butter and sugar in two increments. Gently bring everything together into a soft dough.

**STEP 4** - Roll the dough into small, marble-sized balls with your hands and arrange, spaced out, on baking trays lined with baking parchment.

**STEP 5** - Slightly flatten the top of each ball and press a whole almond or some chopped pistachios in the middle of each one. Chill for 20 mins.

**STEP 6** - Heat the oven to 160C/140C fan/gas 3. Bake the biscuits for about 20 mins or until golden. Leave to cool before storing in an airtight tin.

Well as Diwali approaches we will all have our usual Googra, Chakri and Puris, but how about some Nan Khatai. Something that is baked and not fried. Something you can dish out quickly at tea time when visitors pop in.

### Ingredients

- 3 green cardamom pods
- 40g icing sugar
- 100g unsalted butter, at room temperature
- 70g self-raising white flour
- 25g gram flour
- 25g semolina
- 24 skin-on almonds or chopped pistachios
